### City Council Update

At Tuesday's Council Workshop the City Council considered a proposal from staff to change the holiday schedule for garbage and recycling collection. Under the current system, on city holidays, residential collection is delayed one day and collection throughout the week is shifted back one day. Monday's collection occurs on Tuesday, Tuesday's occurs on Wednesday, Wednesday's occurs on Thursday, Thursday's on Friday, and Friday's on Saturday.

With the new proposal, residential collection will take place on regularly-scheduled pickup days, except three major holidays. The three holidays would be New Year's Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day. Those holidays would operate under the current schedule. On all other holidays, garbage would be collected on the holiday and on the normal collection day throughout the rest of the week.


