AMENDMENT NO. 1
TO
LINKING AGREEMENT
WITH
WEST-LITE SUPPLY CO., INC.
(Avondale Contract No. 13935c, Glendale Contract No. C-9449)

This Amendment No. 1 ("Amendment") to the Linking Agreement with West-Lite Supply Co., Inc. ("Agreement") is made this 2 day of Feb 2016 ("Effective Date"), by and between the City of Glendale, an Arizona municipal corporation ("City") and West-Lite Supply Co., a California corporation authorized to do business in Arizona ("Contractor"), collectively, the "Parties".

RECITALS

- A. City and West-Lite Supply Co., ("Contractor") previously entered into a Linking Agreement, Contract No. C-10612, dated November 24, 2014 ("Agreement") pursuant to the State of Arizona Contract No. ADSPO14-065771; and
- B. The State of Arizona Contract No. ADSPO14-065771 had an initial two-year term beginning January 31, 2014 through January 31, 2016 with the option to extend an additional four (4) years in one-year increments;
- C. The State of Arizona Contract, as amended, expires January 31, 2017; and
- D. City and Contractor wish to modify and amend the Agreement subject to and strictly in accordance with the terms of this Amendment.

AMENDMENT

In consideration of the mutual promises set forth herein and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the City and Contractor hereby agree as follows:

1. **Recitals.** The recitals set forth above are not merely recitals, but form an integral part of this Amendment.
2. **Term.** This Amendment shall extend the term of the Agreement from January 31, 2016 through January 30, 2017. All other provisions of the Agreement and any Amendment thereto shall remain in effect in their entirety.
3. **Compensation.** Remains unchanged.
4. **Ratification of Agreement.** City and Contractor hereby agree that except as expressly provided herein, the provisions of the Agreement shall be, and remain in full force and effect and that if any provision of this Amendment conflicts with the Agreement, then the provisions of this Amendment shall prevail.
