Dear Gary:

We appreciate the service you have rendered to the city of Glendale for the past several years and the value that those services have provided to our community. Based upon the business decision you have made to represent another entity on an issue that is very important to Glendale, we find that our interests are not aligned relative to the sports facility funding discussion currently being undertaken at the Legislature. Glendale cannot be unrepresented during these discussions which directly affect our interests; therefore, we must retain another firm to forward our position on this particular issue.

As a result of this conflict of interest, we must have an amendment to the existing contract between Glendale and Husk partners that allows for the reduction in your monthly retainer during the period which you cannot fully represent Glendale. This reduction will release funding that will allow us to retain another firm for the duration of the legislative session to represent Glendale on the sports facility funding discussions.

Glendale would like Husk Partners to continue to provide representation for the city on all other legislative items impacting the city, including Tohono O'odham issues.
