## C-7762-2 SECOND AMENDMENT TO SUBRECIPIENT CONTRACT

This Second Amendment to Subrecipient Contract C-7762 ("Second Amendment") is made this 30<sup>th</sup> day of July, 2012, by and between the City of Glendale, an Arizona municipal corporation ("City") and Habitat for Humanity Central Arizona, an Arizona non-profit corporation authorized to do business in Arizona ("Agency").

### RECITALS

- A. City and Agency previously entered into a Subrecipient Contract No. C-7762 ("Agreement");
- B. On May 21, 2012, the City and Agency entered into Amendment to Subrecipient Contract ("First Amendment") to increase the contract amount from Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000) to Two Hundred Ninety-One Thousand Nine Hundred Seven Dollars (\$291,907); and
- C. City and Agency wish to further modify and amend the Agreement subject to and strictly in accordance with the terms of this Second Amendment.

### AGREEMENT

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual agreements set forth herein and other good and valuable considerations, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the City and Agency hereby agree as follows:

1. **Recitals.** The recitals set forth above are not merely recitals, but form an integral part of this Second Amendment.
2. **Contract Term.** The contract amount referenced in Section 1.2 of the Agreement and amended by Section 2 of the First Amendment, shall be increased an additional \$45,000 for an amended amount not to exceed the total contract amount of Three Hundred Thirty-Six Thousand Nine Hundred and Seven Dollars (\$336,907).
3. **Ratification of Agreement.** City and Agency hereby agree that except as expressly provided herein, the provisions of the Agreement shall be, and remain in full force and effect and that if any provision of this Second Amendment conflicts with the Agreement, then the provisions of this Second Amendment shall prevail.
