AMENDMENT NO. 1

AGREEMENT FOR SECURITY GUARD SERVICES (Contract No. C-7816) City of Glendale Solicitation No. RFP 12-03

This Amendment No. 1 to the Agreement for Security Guard Services ("Amendment") is made this 25th day of June, 2012 ("Effective Date"), by and between the City of Glendale, an Arizona municipal corporation ("City") and CONFIDENTIAL BACKGROUND INVESTIGATIONS, INC., a Utah corporation authorized to do business in Arizona, doing business as CBI Security Services ("Contractor").

RECITALS

- A. City and Contractor previously entered into an Agreement for Security Guard Services, Contract No. C-7816, dated November 22, 2011 ("Agreement"); and
- B. City and Contractor wish to modify and amend the Agreement subject to and strictly in accordance with the terms of this Amendment.

AGREEMENT

In consideration of the mutual promises set forth herein and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the City and Contractor hereby agree as follows:


1. **Recitals.** The recitals set forth above are not merely recitals, but form an integral part of this Amendment.
2. **Compensation.** Contractor's compensation is amended as of the Effective Date of this Amendment and Exhibit B of the original Agreement is amended as set forth in Exhibit B-Amendment No. 1, attached hereto.
3. **Ratification of Agreement.** City and Contractor hereby agree that except as expressly provided herein, the provisions of the Agreement shall be, and remain in full force and effect and that if any provision of this Amendment conflicts with the Agreement, then the provisions of this Amendment shall prevail.

EXHIBIT B - AMENDMENT NO. 1

RFP 12-03 SECURITY GUARD SERVICES

AMENDED COMPENSATION

METHOD AND AMOUNT OF COMPENSATION

Compensation for services performed will be paid per weekly itemized invoices issued by the Contractor and approved for payment by the Contract Administrator at the rate of \$13.18 per hour for regularly scheduled shifts, \$13.99 per hour for additional sites, and \$18.51 per hour for additional special event and emergency services, if requested by City.

NOT TO EXCEED AMOUNT

Initial one-year period: The total amount of compensation paid to Contractor for full completion of all work required by the Project must not exceed **\$599,550** for the remainder of the initial one-year period which expires November 22, 2012.

Renewal periods: The Agreement may be extended on an annual basis for an additional four years. The total amount of compensation paid to Contractor for full completion of all work required by the Project must not exceed **\$571,000** for the subsequent renewal periods. Price adjustments will only be reviewed during the Agreement renewal periods and must be approved by City Council. Renewals only do not require City Council approval.

DETAILED PROJECT COMPENSATION

Contractor shall submit invoices per the PAYMENT Section of Exhibit A and submit activity reports as requested per the DOCUMENTATION AND REPORTING Section of Exhibit A.
