GLENDALE COUNCILMEMBER DISCUSSES IMPACT OF PROPOSED BUDGET REDUCTIONS & TEMPORARY SALES TAX INCREASE ON UPCOMING TV SHOW

Glendale, Ariz. — Glendale Councilmember Yvonne Knaack, who represents the Barrel District, discusses Glendale's temporary sales tax increase and proposed budget cuts in her new edition of Glendale Today on the city-owned Glendale 11 TV station.

Knaack interviews both the police and fire chiefs about impacts to their budgets and the possibility of laying off firefighters and police officers for the first time in the city's history. She also speaks with the director of Glendale's parks, recreation facilities and libraries about proposed cuts to those areas including shuttering two of Glendale's libraries. Knaack's final guest is Glendale's financial director who reviews the city's budget, previous reductions and the temporary sales tax increase.
