Next Municipal Primary Election: August 30, 2016 (16-204)

Next Municipal General Election: November 8, 2016 (16-204)

As a courtesy, calculations have been provided here; however, please consult your own election advisor and do your own independent calculations.

As per ARS 16-322(A)(9) “If for an office nominated by ward, precinct or other district of a city, by a number of qualified electors who are qualified to vote for the candidate whose nomination petition they are signing equal to at least five per cent and not more than ten per cent of the designated party vote in the ward, precinct or other district, except that a city that chooses to hold nonpartisan elections may provide by ordinance that the minimum number of signatures required for the candidate be two hundred fifty signatures or five per cent of the vote in the district, whichever is less, but not more than ten per cent of the vote in the district.”

Mayor: Minimum 5% - 3,478 Maximum 10% - 6,956

Based on 69,558 total votes for Mayor in the 2012 General

Sahuaro: Minimum 5% - 768 Maximum 10% - 1,536

Based on 15,360 total district votes for Mayor in the 2012 General

Cactus: Minimum 5% - 470 Maximum 10% - 940

Based on 9,395 total district votes for Mayor in the 2012 General

Yucca: Minimum 5% - 464 Maximum 10% - 927

Based on 9,271 total district votes for Mayor in the 2012 General
