


Glendale Community Band Celebrates 46 Years of Summer Concerts in the Heart of Glendale

A Glendale institution celebrates a milestone this year, as the Glendale Summer Band kicked off its 46th season June 7 in downtown Glendale. Sponsored by Glendale's Office of Special Events, the eight-week concert series takes place each Thursday at 8 p.m. during June and July, in the Murphy Park Amphitheater, located at 59th Avenue and Glenn Drive. Music lovers of all ages will be entertained by this community band of approximately 100 musicians with its renditions of marches, ballads and show tunes.

The Glendale Summer Band, conducted by John Faris, is the longest-running community band in Arizona. The ages of the volunteer band members span several generations. The band was formed in 1966, originally playing at O'Neil Park, and moving to Murphy Park when the amphitheater was built.

This free concert is the perfect night out for the entire family. Bring lawn chairs or blankets for seating. Refreshments will be available for purchase at the concerts, which will run through July 26.
