

Is your property in a designated flood hazard area?

Did you know some parts of Glendale are designated by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) as being in a special flood hazard area? Properties in these areas are required to purchase flood insurance as part of their home mortgage. However, other sections of the city are subject to flooding that are not shown on the Flood Insurance Rate Maps (FIRM). Glendale's Engineering Department has copies of the FIRMs for the entire city and can let you know if your property is in a special flood hazard area.

They also have copies of FEMA elevation certificates for some structures within the city and may be able to let you know if flooding has been reported in your area in the past.

All properties within Glendale can obtain flood insurance whether or not you are in a designated flood area. Remember, most standard homeowners' policies do not cover flood loss.

A Message from Councilmember Manny Martinez

Water Safety

Maricopa County has one of the highest drowning rates in the country. Each year we continue to have child drownings in

the Valley – and most are preventable. The good news is that Glendale residents are paying attention.

You can help play a large role in keeping our community safe. If you have children, make sure they know how to swim. A great way to learn water safety and enjoy some family time together is to take advantage of the city's swim lessons.

While at the pool, watch those kids closely. Have a phone in the pool area for emergency calls. If your children use flotation devices (such as floaties) do not depend on them for lifesaving, they are just like other pool toys. If you have a pool, make sure that the barriers are in good working condition,

and that the gate that leads to the pool is always locked. Remove any items that can be used to climb over a pool fence.

Remember the A-B-C's for water safety:

- **Always have adult supervision around water.**
- **Barrier fencing around your pool is extremely important.**
- **CPR. Get involved – take a CPR class.**

There is also potential inside of your home for a drowning as well. Never leave your children while bathing them in the tub or sink. Always have everything you need on hand before you start their bath. Watch other areas – children can also drown in buckets, the toilet, or even a dog's water dish. It only takes 1 – 2 inches of water. While water safety is certainly on everyone's mind as the summer approaches, we really need to think about water safety all year round. The last thing you want to have to say is: "I only looked away for a few minutes..."
