GLENDALE CITY COUNCIL REAFFIRMS SUPPORT FOR TRUST LAND FOR GAMING AND RESORT

Glendale, Ariz. — On Tuesday, Jan. 20, the Glendale City Council voted in favor of approving a resolution that supports the Tohono O’odham Nation developing land within Glendale’s planning area for a proposed casino and resort. The vote officially reaffirms the city’s position to repeal the city’s 2009 position which previously opposed the project and now states that the city officially supports the trust land being utilized for gaming. The vote included official support from Glendale’s three newest councilmembers: Jamie Aldama, Lauren Tolmachoff and Bart Turner.

As with past practice, the Glendale City Clerk will send a copy of the approved resolution to all members of the Arizona Federal Delegation, reaffirming the city’s position. In addition, city staff will continue to negotiate with the Tohono O’odham Nation as previously directed by Council.
