

Glendale's Curbside Recycling Program

Please use the sage green recycling container **ONLY** for the items designated as acceptable materials in the recycling program. Items placed in the recycling container should not be bagged. Items should be relatively clean, dry and empty. Lids and labels do not need to be removed.

What can I place in my sage green recycling container?



Aluminum cans



Corrugated cardboard boxes, dry food boxes (cereal, cracker), empty paper towel tubes, empty pizza boxes (with minimal residue)

- Cardboard boxes should be cut up or broken down to fit better in the container.
- Remove waxy lining from cereal/ cake boxes.



All newspaper and inserts



All magazines and telephone books



Food cans that hold soup, vegetables, pet food, tuna. Empty aerosol cans are accepted

- Aerosol cans **MUST** be empty
- No propane tanks



White and colored paper, computer paper, junk mail, file folders, paper grocery bags, windowed envelopes

- No hardbound books



All plastic containers that carry the recycling symbol of #1 thru #7 such as milk jugs, soda bottles, water bottles, detergent bottles, beverage cups, margarine tubs, sour cream, plastic food packaging.
No styrofoam.

Items that **SHOULD NOT** be placed in your sage green recycling container

| Fast food items | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• food, straws, cups, wrappers |
| Food | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• of any kind |
| Glass | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• vases, bottles, light bulbs, window glass, ceramics |
| Hangers | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• metal or plastic |
| Household garbage | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• dirty diapers, furnace filters, dog waste, paper towels, napkins, paper plates, mops, brooms, bathroom supplies, vacuums, sponges |
| Landscaping | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• grass/tree trimmings (leaves, branches), dirt, rocks |
| Plastic | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• BAGS (of any kind), silverware, pvc, bubble wrap, motor oil containers |
| Styrofoam | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• food containers, dinner plates, cups, egg cartons, packaging, packing peanuts |
| Tires | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• tires, inner tubes |
| Other | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• garden hoses, scrap metal, small appliances, batteries, animal feed bags-such as dog/cat food |
| Construction waste | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• cement, cement dust, sawdust, wood, nails |
| Electrical | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• electrical cords, wiring, Christmas lights, car batteries |
| Metal | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• small appliances, ceiling fans, mini blinds, folding chairs, propane tanks, auto/car parts |
| Plastic | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• toys, pool covers, pool floats, mini blinds |
| Yard waste | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• rubber hoses, wood, rope |
