Smart Irrigation Month is a public awareness campaign to promote efficient water use. The national campaign highlights simple practices and innovative technologies to help homeowners minimize overwatering while keeping lawns, gardens, and landscapes healthy and attractive.

Homeowners typically overwater lawns and landscapes by as much as 30 percent. By selecting and planting carefully, watering wisely, and maintaining and upgrading automated irrigation systems, homeowners can save money, save water and see better results. Residents can improve water efficiency in their landscape through free print and online resources, offered by the city of Glendale Conservation and Sustainable Living Program.
