IT'S OFFICIAL!

The city of Glendale awarded a contract to Combs Construction Company, Inc. to construct a new parking

lot on the southwest corner of 91st and Maryland avenues. Additional improvements planned for the new parking lot site include the installation of storm water basins, curb, sidewalk, a screen wall and lighting.

Currently, construction is underway and the project is slated for completion in early August 2016.

Construction work hours are 6:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. Crews may work nights and weekends, if needed and approved by the city.

PROJECT BENEFIT

The new parking lot will add 2,700 parking spaces to accommodate the growing number of visitors and employees to the Westgate Center. The parking lot expansion is being constructed on the former Pendergast farm property.

CONSTRUCTION PLANS

Crews now are excavating the parking lot site and removing existing buildings, concrete slabs and foundations. Other activities scheduled in May include grading the site, excavating storm water basins, placing concrete for catch basins and light pole bases and installing a screen wall and electric lines.

TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS

The majority of the work takes place on the roadway on the parking lot site. However, there may be traffic lane restrictions during the construction effort. Access will be maintained at all times for residents, businesses and emergency vehicles.


Please allow extra time when traveling through the construction zone as there may be traffic delays.


