

Councilmember Sam Chavira of the Yucca District focuses on the very important topic of safety awareness on his new edition of the TV show "Glendale Today." Councilmember Chavira's guest on the program is Glendale Fire Chief Terry Garrison, and the topics include home, workplace, traffic and water safety and what you can do to keep your family safe.

June marked 'National Safety Month' and the show first highlights personal safety, the importance of learning Continuous Chest Compression (CCC) and the many city programs offered to families regarding drowning prevention and keeping safe around water. The second half introduces viewers to new Fire Chief Garrison, who started as a Phoenix firefighter in 1977 and worked in various fire departments including most recently as Fire Chief in Houston, Texas.
