Background

- City receives an annual federal allocation from HUD to fund Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), HOME Investment Partnerships (HOME), and Emergency Solutions Grants (ESG) Programs
- Programs collectively assist over 40,000 Glendale residents annually
- City expects \$2.5 million in federal funding for FY 2013-14

CDAC Public Process

- Grant Orientation Session - September 2012
- CDAC Receives Application Binders - November 2012
- Five Public Hearings/Meetings - January 2013
- 30 day Public Comment Period - March/April 2013
- City Council Public Hearing/Approval - April 2013

Last Year's Funding Priorities

- Keeping people in their homes
- Keeping neighborhoods stabilized
- Providing emergency home repairs
- Assistance with core needs such as food, utilities and shelter
