Background

- ❑ Glendale receives an annual federal allocation from HUD to fund Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), HOME Investment Partnerships (HOME), and Emergency Solutions Grants (ESG) Programs
- ❑ For the current year, the City was allocated \$2.72 million in federal funding for these programs
- ❑ Programs collectively assist over 37,800 Glendale residents annually

Last Year's Funding Priorities

- ❑ Keeping people in their homes
- ❑ Assisting with core needs such as food, utilities and shelter
- ❑ Supporting home delivery of meals and shelter services programs
- ❑ Providing emergency home repair
- ❑ Housing rehabilitation programs
- ❑ Demolishing and clearing blighted structures
- ❑ Emphasizing revitalization of Centerline/Redevelopment Area
