IV. Amendment to Current Contract with ACAA for Additional Funds

Summary: This is a request for the CDAC to approve Amendment No. 1 to an existing agreement with the Arizona Community Action Association (ACAA) to accept \$13,235 in Community Action Program (CAP) funding. If approved by CDAC and subsequently by the City Council on January 26, 2016, these additional funds will allow staff to assist approximately 80 more Glendale residents with direct utility assistance. This is significant in that many of the individuals seeking such assistance must often make the difficult choice of whether to use their limited resources on sustenance or basic shelter. The additional utility assistance funds will provide immediate relief to those who are striving to become self-sufficient.

Recommendation: Review and approve.

V. Fiscal Year (FY) 2016-17 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), HOME Investment Partnerships Program (HOME), and Emergency Solutions Grants (ESG) Funding Request Recommendations
