2. **DUE DATE: The Letter of Intent must be submitted to the Community Revitalization Division by scanning and/or emailing the "signed form" to bcoughenour@glendaleaz.com or faxing it to 623-435-8594 BY 5:00 p.m., FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 15, 2013.** If the Letter of Intent is not received **by Friday, November 15, 2013**, we cannot guarantee access for submitting an application online with Valley of the Sun United Way.

PLEASE NOTE: Once the Letter of Intent to Apply is received by our office, a profile will be created by Valley of the Sun United Way to allow access to the online application system. It will take approximately one to two days to review/ set up an individual password.

3. **FINAL STEP: GRANT APPLICATIONS MUST BE COMPLETED AND SUBMITTED ONLINE BY 5:00 p.m. on FRIDAY, DECEMBER 6, 2013.**
