**V. Community Center Introductions – 30 minutes**

Summary: Department staff engaged private sector organizations to conduct after-school, recreational and cultural type programs at three Glendale community centers. In November 2015, the concept was expanded to include Community Center North. The city currently has agreements with four non-profit groups to provide recreational and mentoring programs at four neighborhood community centers.

Recommendation: For informational purposes.

**VI. Storm Management – 15 minutes**

Summary: Large-scale storm events that cause excessive damage to parks can compromise public safety. Staff will update the commission on the recent storm event, infrastructure damage, and protocols used to mitigate storm damage within the parks.

Recommendation: For Commission review and discussion.

**VII. Glen Lakes Golf Course – 10 minutes**

Summary: In November 2012, the City Council approved a three-year operating and management agreement with AZ Golf Ventures, LLC, which expires December 1, 2015. At the City Council Workshop on October 20, 2015, City Council decided against the possible sale of the golf course and provided staff direction to continue operating this property as a municipal golf course.

Recommendation: For Commission discussion and approval to move forward with a new 24-month contract with Arizona Golf Ventures, LLC for the continued operation and management of the Glen Lakes Municipal Golf Course.

Summary: The Parks and Recreation staff will share information with the Commission on key activities since its last meeting. This will also include the sharing of information related to previous requests of the Commission and an update on future department and city events that may be of interest.
