AMENDMENT NO. 2

AGREEMENT FOR BOARD UP SERVICES
(City of Glendale Solicitation No. IFB 13-22, Contract No. C-8715)

This Amendment No. 2 ("Amendment") to the Agreement for Board Up Services ("Agreement") is made this 6 day of November, 2015, ("Effective Date"), by and between the City of Glendale, an Arizona municipal corporation ("City") and Arizona Fire & Water Restoration, Inc., an Arizona corporation ("Contractor").

RECITALS

- A. City and Arizona Fire & Water Restoration, Inc., ("Contractor") previously entered into an Agreement for Board Up Services, Contract No. C-8715, dated November 4, 2013 ("Agreement"); and
- B. The Agreement had an initial one-year term beginning November 4, 2013 through November 3, 2014 and provided the option to extend for an additional four (4) years in one-year increments; and
- C. City and Contractor previously entered into Agreement Amendment No. 1, extending the term of the Agreement from November 4, 2014 through November 3, 2015; and
- D. City and Contractor wish to modify and amend the Agreement subject to and strictly in accordance with the terms of this Amendment.

AGREEMENT

In consideration of the mutual promises set forth herein and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the City and Contractor hereby agree as follows:

- 1. **Recitals.** The recitals set forth above are not merely recitals, but form an integral part of this Amendment.
- 2. **Term.** The term of the Agreement is extended for a one-year period from November 4, 2015 through November 3, 2016, unless otherwise terminated or canceled as provided by the Agreement. All other provisions of the Agreement except as set forth in this Amendment shall remain in their entirety.
- 3. **Scope of Work.** The Scope of Work is unchanged.

4. **Compensation.** The compensation of the Agreement is unchanged and shall not exceed \$49,999 for full completion of all work required by the Project during the entire term of the Project.
5. **Non-discrimination.** Contractor must not discriminate against any employee or applicant for employment on the basis of race, color, religion, sex, national origin, age, marital status, sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, genetic characteristics, familial status, U.S. military veteran status or any disability. Contractor will require any Sub-contractor to be bound to the same requirements as stated within this section. Contractor, and on behalf of any subcontractors, warrants compliance with this section.
6. **Insurance Certificate.** Current certificate will expire on February 1, 2016 and a new certificate applying to the extended term must be provided prior to this date to Materials Management and the Contract Administrator.
7. **Ratification of Agreement.** City and Contractor hereby agree that except as expressly provided herein, the provisions of the Agreement shall be, and remain in full force and effect and that if any provision of this Amendment conflicts with the Agreement, then the provisions of this Amendment shall prevail.
