**AMENDMENT TO
SUBRECIPIENT CONTRACT**

This Amendment to Subrecipient Contract C-9369 ("Amendment") is made this 23rd day of September, 2015, by and between the City of Glendale, an Arizona municipal corporation ("City") and Hope for Hunger Corporation, an Arizona non-profit corporation authorized to do business in Arizona ("Agency").

RECITALS

- A. City and Agency previously entered into a Subrecipient Contract No. C-9369 ("Agreement");
- B. The Agreement expires on September 30, 2015. The City and Agency wish to extend the term pursuant to this Amendment.
- C. City and Agency wish to modify and amend the Agreement subject to and strictly in accordance with the terms of this Amendment.

AGREEMENT

1. **Recitals.** The recitals set forth above are not merely recitals, but form an integral part of this Amendment.
2. **Contract Term.** The term of the Agreement is extended until December 31, 2015.
3. **Section 8 of the Agreement is amended as follows:**

Section 8.2 Records Retention is amended to require the Agency to retain all records pertinent to expenditures incurred under this Contract for a period of six years from the date the Agreement terminates.

Section 8.3 Uniform Administrative Requirements is amended to require Agency to comply with HUD Notice SD-2015-01 issued February 26, 2015 and 2 CFR Part 200, Uniform Administrative Requirements, cost Principles, and audit Requirements for Federal Awards, Final guidance.

4. **Section 15 is amended as follows:**

Non-discrimination. The Agency will not discriminate against any employee or applicant for employment on the basis of race, color, religion, sex, national origin, age, marital status, sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, genetic characteristics, familial status, U.S. military veteran status or any disability. The Agency will take affirmative steps to ensure that employees, applicants for employment, and applicants for services are treated without regard to race, color, religion, sex, national origin, age, marital status, sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, genetic characteristics, familial status, U.S. military veteran status or any disability. The Agency will post in a conspicuous place, available to employees and the public, notices setting forth the provisions of this non-discrimination


clause. The Agency will, in all solicitations and advertisements, state that all applicants will receive consideration for employment or service without regard of race, color, religion, sex, national origin, age, marital status, sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, genetic characteristics, familial status, U.S. military veteran status or any disability.

- 5. **Ratification of Agreement.** City and Agency hereby agree that, except as expressly provided herein, the provisions of the Agreement shall be, and remain in full force and effect. If any provision of this Amendment conflicts with the Agreement, then the provisions of this Amendment shall prevail.


